Council ground levy & usage charges

Dave Porter outlined Council fees for Building on crown land (License agreement) Cheney Park Clubhouse

21/22 season \$2,490 - 22/23 season \$4,360 - 22/24 season \$5334

21/22 season also had a 50% discount due to impact of COVID on local sports.

22/23 season include a discount due to wet weather that impacted sports from November 2022 floods.

23/24 season higher than the last few seasons without any discounts applied.
